

## House Wine

### Cambas Greek Heritage

#### Red



A bright dry red with a pleasant ripe grape aroma of red fruits. Very easy to drink and smooth on the palate. Deep ruby colour, soft mature bouquet with a hint of vanilla and cinnamon. Full-bodied with a fine balance of ripe currant, blackberry and oak overtones.

#### White



A fresh and very pleasant dry white wine, with pale yellow colour. It has a subtle flowery aroma and a smooth soft taste. Very refreshing and clean on the palate. Will accompany nicely dishes with salads, cheese, fish, seafood and any light Mediterranean dishes.

(100% **Savatiano**)

#### Rosè



A fresh wine with a brilliant pink colour, intense aroma of red fruits (cherry, tomato) pleasant taste, nervous with long aromatic aftertaste. A good choice for our Meze Banquets as it will fit nicely amongst the various flavours.

## Retsina

### Retsina (Kourtaki)

£13.50



(100% **Savatiano**) A robust wine characterised by its pine resin flavour. A favourite in the traditional Greek tavernas and has gained, in recent years, popularity with its unique taste. Produced from grapes grown in Attica.

### Ritinitis Nobilis (Gaia)

£18.50



(100% **Roditis**) The only high quality retsina available in the market today. Displays a refreshing taste balanced perfectly between pine and grapes. On the nose hints of mint and eucalyptus. Its lively citrus expression co-existing with aromatic pine within a soft and creamy palate.

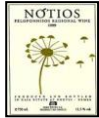
## White Wines

Thisbe (KEO) *easy to drink (like chardonnay)* £16.50



(100% **Xynisteri**) A light bodied, **medium dry**, fruity wine from Cyprus with a distinctive floral aroma. Apples and hints of peach on the palate. Produced from grapes grown in the Akamas region in Paphos cropped early in order to obtain low alcohol content.

Notios White (Gaia) *fresh, zesty* £19.50



(**Moschofilero**, **Roditis**) Moschofilero grapes from the Arcadian plateaus give a vibrant floral flavour while Roditis grapes from Corinth add a smooth lemony touch. Initially sweet with refreshing acidity, light with mineral taste and a sense of lemon at the finish.

Thalassitis AO Santorini (Gaia) *crisp, vibrant* £24.00



(100% **Assyrtiko**) Aromas of citrus, honeysuckle, pepper and an edge of tart apples. Initial sweetness quickly makes way for acidity and the salty mineral taste of the volcanic terroir that lead to a crisp finish. A superb wine full of personality.

Nobile (Creta Olympias) *lush, fruity* £25.50



(100% **Vilana**) A nose of citrus and lime aromas, with hints of grapefruit and peach. On the palate, its elegant acidity balances the tropical fruit and the creamy vanilla notes on a smooth, rich, mouth watering texture. Its subtle complexity prolongs the finish.

Malagousia (Gerovassiliou) *vibrant, vivid fruit* £26.50



(100% **Malagousia**) A floral, aromatic nose balanced by crisp acidity, leads to a full, complex and vivid palate displaying nuances of peach and white stone fruits. Excellent balance and length supporting an extraordinarily delicate array of fruit flavours.

## Rosé Wines

St George 14-18h (Gaia) *crisp, fresh* £21.00



(100% **St George**) A dry, full bodied, crisp wine with an intense rose colour and a fruity aroma dominated by cherry and gooseberry. Has a cool refreshing taste and relatively low acidity. Its name refers to the amount of hours that the skin is in contact with the must in order to acquire its rosy hue.

## Red Wines

Paranga (Kir-Yianni) *fresh, nicely balanced* £15.50



(50% **Xinomavro**, 20% **St George**, 15% **Syrah**, 15% **Merlot**)

Light cherry colour with soft red forest fruits on the nose. Well balanced with a nice acidity and length. Full-bodied, refreshing and easy to drink with shades of spice and floral aromas.

Naoussa (Boutari) *warm, spicy and smooth* £18.50



(100% **Xinomavro**) Deep red in colour with an intense personality. It gives off a rich bouquet of ripe red fruit and aromas that come from ageing (cinnamon, wood) followed by hints of chocolate and vanilla. Full-bodied, well-balanced, with soft tannins at the finish.

Notios Red (Gaia) *fruity, vibrant* £19.50



(100% **St George**) From the Nemea region, a modern, young, yet sophisticated wine with a velvet carpet of red fruit and a cut of fresh acidity. Deeply coloured with a discreet woody scent. A low tannin content underscores its rich, well structured, velvety body.

Yiannakohori (Kir Yianni) *fruity, slightly spiced* £22.00



(**Merlot**, **Xinomavro**) Intense red colour and a rich bouquet with tinges of white pepper and cedar. Good acidity and big structure with balance between fruit and tannins. Becomes more supple with ageing. Flavours of plum, raspberry, mint with a hint of cinnamon.

Cava Cambas Reserve (Cambas) *fruity with velvety elegance* £32.00



(100% **St George**) This exquisite wine comes in a mud covered bottle and has a unique appearance. Deep ruby colour, soft mature bouquet (vanilla, cinnamon) and velvety smooth fruity flavour. Full bodied with a long lasting aftertaste. Fine balance of ripe currant, blackberry and oak overtones. This is a reserve wine only produced in vintage years.

## Dessert Wines

St. John Commandaria (50ml) *warm spice, fruity* £3.50



This unique wine from Cyprus appreciated since ancient times was made famous by the Knights of St John during the 11<sup>th</sup> century crusades. Charmingly sweet with a powerful bouquet of dried fruits (raisin, fig), spices and oak. It is luscious and full-bodied.
